- Accompanying students to specials classes.

Support for students

- Being kind and loving to students which builds trust.
- Helping students prepare and work through a lesson.
 - Assist with cleaning up the areas where learning takes place, or organizing materials
 - o Redirect students who are struggling to stay on task
 - Reiterate to students the instructions
 - Show students how to do the task assigned to them
- Assist students as necessary with bathroom duties.
- Provide emotional support for a student who is struggling.

As a teacher's aide in a Christian school, a GLS aide is also expected to...

- Establish a caring relationship with each student
- Share personal faith with students and colleagues
- Have words and actions that exemplify Christian conduct
