

Dear Parents of Grace Lutheran School,

The Grace early evening worship services on Christmas Eve are led by the children of Grace Church and School. All children in grades 1–8 are encouraged to be involved in this annual highlight of our school year. The illuminated cross formed by the 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will begin the service for the 75<sup>th</sup> consecutive year. Students prepare carefully for the responsibility of leading worship and look forward to sharing the joy of Christ's birth on Christmas Eve. This tradition lives on in the hearts of students even after they graduate from Grace. Alumni return year after year to experience the beauty of this service. If your child has not been part of Christmas Eve at Grace in the past, we invite him/her to participate this year.

## **Children in Grades 1-4**

• Children in grades 1-4 may participate in one service or both. This year, families with last names beginning M-Z will sing for the 4:15 p.m. service, and A-L will sing for the 6 p.m. service.

## Children in Grades 5-8

- Children in Grades 5–8 have the option to participate in the choir or in the costumed pageant.
- Members of the Choir and the School Handbell Choir (Strike Team) <u>must</u> be present for BOTH services. If
  participation in both services is not possible for your child, being in the pageant for one service is an option. If
  there is a special circumstance that you would like to discuss, please email Mrs. Underhill.
- Students in the School Handbell Choir will ring during the service and will also participate in Grace's traditional Christmas Cross.
- Children in the pageant participate in one *or* both services.
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade students may also be readers at one or both services, as assigned. They rehearse with Ms. Gwen Gotsch, times to be arranged.
